SENATE No. 1397

By Mr. DiCarlo, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Joseph J. C. DiCarlo, Robert F. Donovan and Francis D. Doris for legislation to direct the Massachusetts Port Authority to pay certain fees to the cities of Boston and Chelsea. Transportation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO PAY CERTAIN FEES TO THE CITIES OF BOSTON AND CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956, as most recently
2 amended by Section 6 of Chapter 719 of the Acts of 1967, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting at the end of Section 17
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 17A.* Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 17
6 to the contrary, the authority shall pay to the city of Boston
7 and to the city of Chelsea a fee of two and one-half cents per
8 vehicle assessed a toll for the use of the Mystic River Bridge
9 under the authority of Section 14 of this act.

10 The commissioner of corporations and taxation shall de-
11 termine the procedure by which the authority shall make said
12 payment.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect on
2 January 1, 1977.
