By Mr. LoPresti, a petition of Michael LoPresti, Jr., for legislation to extend the time concerning the controls over certain tidelands along the Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME CONCERNING THE CONTROLS OVER CERTAIN TIDELANDS ALONG THE ATLANTIC AVENUE AND COMMERCIAL STREET WATERFRONT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 310 of the Acts of 1972 is hereby
- 2 amended by deleting in the first sentence of both the first and
- 3 second paragraphs of said section the words "seventy-seven"
- 4 and inserting in place thereof the words "eighty-two".

By the Senate, a bill of the Senate, to be known as the
act for the purpose of providing for the relief of the

IN RELATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHANCELLOR AND COMMISSIONER,
AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY CHARTER.

Enacted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of New York,
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.

1. Section 1 of Chapter 219 of the Laws of 1872 is hereby
repealed, and the following is substituted therefor: "The
University of the State of New York shall be a corporation,
and shall have the seal of the State of New York."
2. Section 2 of Chapter 219 of the Laws of 1872 is hereby
repealed, and the following is substituted therefor: "The
University of the State of New York shall have the seal of the
State of New York."
