AN ACT PROHIBITING THE PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR CERTAIN ATTORNEYS IN THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 12, as most recently amended by section 7
- 2 of Chapter 689 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by
- 3 adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph: —
- 4 All attorneys, employed full time by the Department of the
- 5 Attorney General, shall devote their entire time during ordinary
- 6 business hours to their duties, and shall neither directly nor
- 7 indirectly engage in the practice of law.
