The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A HIGHWAY SAFETY DEVICE REPLACEMENT ACCOUNT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 81 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 13B, section 13C.

3 The commonwealth shall receive monies paid by persons in
4 satisfaction of claims by the commonwealth for damage to
5 highway safety signs, signals, guard rail, curbing and other
6 highway improvements and credit such monies to a fund to be
7 known as the Highway Repair Fund, which shall be a subsidiary
8 account of the Highway Fund. Said Highway Repair Fund shall be
9 used solely for the construction and repair of such damaged
10 highway improvements.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 90 Section 34 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding in the first paragraph after the words
3 chapter 64A the following:—

4 “All amounts paid into the Highway Repair Fund established
5 under section 13C of chapter 81.”
