AN ACT ELIMINATING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A WHOLESALE'S LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF CIGARETTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 67 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, inserted by
2 section 22 of the acts of 1976, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph: —

5 Each vendor, as defined in chapters sixty-four H or sixty-four I,
6 each taxpayer as defined in chapter sixty-four B, and each operator
7 as defined in chapter sixty-four G who desires to obtain a
8 certificate of registration as required by those chapters, and each
9 person who desires to obtain a license as a distributor, unclassified
10 importer, or unclassified exporter, as defined in chapter sixty-four
11 A, as a manufacturer, wholesaler, vending machine operator,
12 unclassified acquirer, transportation company, or retailer, as
13 defined in chapter sixty-four C, as a user-seller, supplier, or user of
14 special fuels, as defined in chapter sixty-four E, or as a motor
15 carrier, as defined in chapter sixty-four F shall file with the
16 commissioner an application in such form as the commissioner,
17 with the approval of the commission, prescribes, giving such
18 information as the commissioner requires.
