AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TREASURER OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO DISTRIBUTE CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE STATE LOTTERY TO CITIES AND TOWNS TO ALLEVIATE REAL ESTATE TAX BURDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of chapter ten of the General
2 Laws, the treasurer of the commonwealth is hereby authorized and
3 directed to distribute two hundred and fifty million dollars derived
4 from the state lottery to the cities and towns for the purpose of
5 reducing real estate taxes.
