AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AGE REQUIRED TO ATTAIN THE STATUS OF SENIOR CITIZEN AND THE BENEFITS THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to
- 2 the contrary, any person who is 62 years of age or older shall be
- 3 considered as a senior citizen and shall be allowed to participate in,
- 4 and receive the benefits of, and programs currently established for
- 5 citizens 65 years of age or older or seventy years of age or older.
