## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT DESIGNATING MAY TWENTY-NINTH OF EACH YEAR A MASSACHUSETTS LEGAL HOLIDAY IN HONOR OF JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out clause Eighteenth, as most recently amended by  
3 section 1 of chapter 112 of the acts of 1976, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following clause:—

5 Eighteenth. January first, January fifteenth, May twentieth,  
6 May twenty-ninth, July fourth and Christmas Day, on the day  
7 following when any of said days occur on Sunday, and the third  
8 Monday in February, the third Monday in April, the last  
9 Monday in May, the first Monday in September, the second  
10 Monday in October, November eleventh, the fourth Monday in  
11 October and Thanksgiving day. "Legal holiday" shall also  
12 include, with respect to Suffolk county only, March the  
13 seventeenth and June the seventeenth, or the day following when  
14 said days occur on Sunday; provided, however, that the words  
15 "legal holiday" as used in section forty-five of chapter one  
16 hundred and forty-nine shall not include March the seventeenth,  
17 May twentieth, or the day following when said day occurs on  
18 Sunday.
