## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

### AN ACT TO MAKE SEXUALLY NEUTRAL THE PROSTITUTION STATUTE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That the words female, her, and men be removed from the  
2 definition of prostitute under chapter 277, section 79, of the  
3 Massachusetts General Laws and be replaced by the words  
4 person, their, and men or women.

5 The section to then read:

6 Prostitute: — That A.B. a person, was a prostitute offering their  
7 body to indiscriminate intercourse with men or women for hire.
