### AN ACT LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF SELF-SERVICE GAS STATIONS TO TEN PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF GAS STATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 295B of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 12 of chapter 684 of the acts of 1972, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 The division, in issuing licenses under this section, shall not issue
- 5 to self-service stations a percentage greater than ten percent of the
- 6 total licenses issued.
