RESOLVE CREATING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY THE CASE PROCESSING GUIDELINES AND FACT FINDING CONFERENCES UTILIZED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS COMMISSION AGAINST DISCRIMINATION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor at least
4 two of whom shall be attorneys is hereby established for the
5 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the case
6 processing guidelines and fact finding conferences utilized by the
7 massachusetts commission against discrimination, its efficiency
8 and case load, and other related matters.
