The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EDUCATIONAL REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER SEVENTY OF THE GENERAL LAWS BE FUNDED IN FULL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 58 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 18A, as most recently amended by section 54 of chapter
3 363A of the acts of 1977, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 18A.* The commission shall annually, commencing with
6 the fiscal year commencing on July first, nineteen hundred and
7 seventy-eight, distribute the awards due under chapters seventy-
8 one A and seventy-one B and under section seven of chapter
9 seventy-six on or before November first, and the amounts due
10 under chapters seventy-one A and seventy-one B and under section
11 seven of chapter seventy-six on or before November first, and the
12 amounts due under chapter seventy from time to time but not less
13 than approximately twenty-five percent thereof on or before the
14 last calendar day of each quarter.
