## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAMS FOR NATURALLY TALENTED CHILDREN.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-  
3 tatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making a study and investigation  
5 relative to the establishment of special programs for naturally  
6 talented children at the pre-school and kindergarten levels. Said  
7 study and investigation shall consider information and recommen-  
8 dations supplied by organizations of retired citizens, artists, public  
9 school and private school instructors, and other interested  
10 persons.
