AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE TO ABUTTERS PRIOR TO HEARINGS UNDER THE HATCH ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first sentence of the third paragraph of section 40 of chapter
- 2 131 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 245
- 3 of chapter 706 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by
- 4 adding the following words: — and such notice shall also be given
- 5 to abutters of each assessed owner.
