## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

### **AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PERMANENT CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONAL STATE EMPLOYEES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 15 of chapter 31 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 1977 is hereby further
- 3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 Any person who has been a provisional employee in a city or
- 5 town for five years shall be eligible to become a permanent
- 6 employee with the approval of the appointing authority.
