AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PERMANENT CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONAL STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15 of chapter 31 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 1977 is hereby further
- 3 amended by adding the following paragraph: -
- 4 Any person who has been a provisional employee in a city or
- 5 town for five years shall be eligible to become a permanent
- 6 employee with the approval of the appointing authority.
