By Mr. Collins of Amherst, petition of James G. Collins for legislation to require in-service and supervisory training for any person appointed a police officer with the University of Massachusetts police. Public Service.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT REQUIRING IN-SERVICE AND SUPERVISORY TRAINING FOR ANY PERSON APPOINTED A POLICE OFFICER WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 96B of chapter 41 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting in line 5 of the first paragraph as
3 appearing in chapter 697 of the acts of 1972, after the words "police
4 powers" the following words: — or any person the trustees of the
5 University of Massachusetts shall appoint as a police officer under
6 section thirty-two A of chapter seventy-five.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 96B of said chapter 41 is hereby
2 further amended by inserting in line 4 of paragraph 2, as appearing
3 in chapter 697 of the acts of 1972, after the words "police powers",
4 the following words:— "or any person the trustees of the
5 University of Massachusetts shall appoint as a police officer under
6 section thirty-two A of chapter seventy-five."
