AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN APPOINTED UNDER CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.
