AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM CHARGE OF A MEAL UPON WHICH AN  
EXCISE FOR MEALS IS LEVIED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The paragraph defining taxable charge in section 1 of chapter  
2 64B of the General Laws, as appearing in section 44A of chapter  
3 555 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3,  
4 the words "one dollar" and inserting in place thereof the following  
5 words: — two dollars.
