## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES MAY OBTAIN CERTAIN DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, any employee of the commonwealth or the city of  
3 Boston may obtain disability retirement benefits after twenty years  
4 of creditable service, regardless of age, provided that such person  
5 qualifies for such benefits under all other requirements of law.
