## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REGULATING THE SALARIES OF DEPUTY SHERIFFS WHO ARE EMPLOYED ON A PER DIEM BASIS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 17 of chapter 34 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following  
4 sentence: — A deputy sheriff who is employed on a per diem basis  
5 shall be entitled to the same percentage increase as a deputy sheriff  
6 who is a full-time employee.
