AN ACT MANDATING REIMBURSEMENT OF ONE HUNDRED PERCENT FOR EXPENDITURES BY CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The provisions of any general or special law to the contrary
2 notwithstanding, the department of education shall certify and the
3 state treasurer shall pay to every city and town one hundred
4 percent of its expenditures for special needs programs as
5 authorized by chapter seven hundred and sixty-six of the acts of
6 nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
