AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS FOR THE ATTENDANCE OF POLICE OFFICERS AND OTHER WITNESSES AT COURT PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 280 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 2 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 2A.* The superior or district court may, upon conviction of crime, assess against the defendant costs incurred for the
- 4 attendance at court proceedings of police officers and other
- 5 witnesses. The money collected from the assessment of such costs
- 6 shall be paid to the city or town where the offense occurred.
