AN ACT AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL PLANNING BOARDS TO EMPLOY LEGAL COUNSEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 81A of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 565 of the acts of 1975, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the eighth sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Such a board shall elect annually
5 a chairman and a clerk from among its own number and may
6 employ experts including legal counsel and clerical and other
7 assistants.
