AN ACT PROHIBITING ANY JOB CURRENTLY PERFORMED OR CAPABLE OF BEING PERFORMED BY EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH FROM BEING CONTRACTED OUT TO PRIVATE CONCERNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 44M the following section:—
- 3 *Section 44N.* No job currently performed by employees of the
- 4 commonwealth or capable of being performed by employees of the
- 5 commonwealth, shall be contracted out to private concerns.
