AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DIVISION OF MARINE AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section one of chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the definition of word "division" as
- 3 appearing in section three of chapter 103 of the acts of 1971 and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the following definition: —
- 5 "division" — the division of marine and recreational vehicles in
- 6 the Department of Fisheries, Wildlife and Recreational Vehicles.
