RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ACCIDENT PRONE AREAS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two members
2 of the senate, three members of the house of representatives, the
3 registrar of motor vehicles or his designee and four persons to be
4 appointed by the governor, one of whom shall a representative
5 from the insurance industry, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study relative to the accident prone
7 areas in the commonwealth.
