AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF SPECIAL ELIGIBLE LISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 12 of chapter 31 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the
- 3 end of said paragraph:— No rule shall be made or enforced
- 4 providing for separate eligible lists for any position within the
- 5 service.
