AN ACT AUTHORIZING TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE EXCHANGES FOR
CONSTITUENT CONTACT WITH MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 9B the following section: —

3 *Section 9C.* There shall be provided for each member of the
4 general court a toll-free telephone exchange whereby constituents
5 of each such member may place telephone calls to such member's
6 office at the state house without charge.
