AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES BY THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS OFFICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 19 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 19A.* A person shall not be employed as a temporary
- 4 employee in the sergeant-at-arms office for more than sixty
- 5 working days in any one calendar year.
