## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, regulation or rule to  
2 the contrary any person who employs ten or more people and who  
3 contracts with, a city, town, county, or the state government to  
4 perform work for said government shall employ people of age  
5 twenty-five and under in a minimum of ten per cent of his work  
6 force in order to qualify for performing any contract with said  
7 governments.
