RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO A REDUCTION OF THE AMOUNT OF PAPER WORK USED IN GOVERNMENT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, six members of the house of representa-
3 tives, the state secretary, the secretary of administration and
4 finance and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
5 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and
6 study relative to the amount of paper work used in government and
7 possible methods to reduce the amount of paperwork. Said
8 commission shall file its final report on or before June fifteenth,
9 nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
