

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4571

By Mr. Freeman of Chelmsford, petition of Bruce N. Freeman for legislation to reduce to sixty-five years the age of eligibility for certain real estate tax exemptions. Taxation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE TO SIXTY-FIVE FOR ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS FOR EXEMPTIONS FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 456 of the Acts  
3 of 1970, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4, 6, and 7, the  
4 word "seventy" and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the  
5 word: —sixty-five.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxes levied for the year  
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-eight and subsequent years.
