AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PROVISION FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM FOR THE
TREASURER-COLLECTOR IN THE CITY OF MELROSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 12 of chapter 162 of the acts of 1899 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after the third sentence the following sentence: — Said
- 3 officer shall, at his first and each succeeding election, be elected for
- 4 the term of three years.
