AN ACT REQUIRING ANY APPLICANT FOR A POLICE PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION TO HAVE A BACHELOR OF ARTS OR BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT OR CRIMINAL JUSTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 389 of the acts of 1976, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the third sentence of the first
4 paragraph the following sentence: — No person shall be eligible to
5 take a police promotional examination unless such person has
6 received a bachelor of arts or bachelor of science degree in law
7 enforcement or criminal justice from an accredited institute of
8 higher learning.
