AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SEMIANNUAL PERIODIC INSPECTION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 233 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the fifth sentence the following
4 sentence:— Such rules and regulations shall provide for the
5 issuance of a rejection sticker whenever such equipment, except for
6 braking and steering systems, is found to be in such a defective
7 condition that twenty-five dollars of repairs are necessary,
8 provided that such vehicle may be operated for a period of 10 days
9 from the date such rejection sticker is affixed.
