## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF POLICE OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AT AMHERST.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The personnel administrator of the division of personnel  
2 administration within the executive office for administration and  
3 finance is hereby authorized and directed to classify police officers  
4 employed by the University of Massachusetts at Amherst in the  
5 following categories:— Patrolman to Grade 14; sergeant to grade  
6 16; lieutenant to grade 17.
