AN ACT REQUIRING FLEA MARKET OPERATORS TO REPORT THE NAMES OF VENDORS TO THE COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 24 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 24A.* Whoever operates or organizes any flea market,
- 4 so-called, shall, within twenty-four hours of the completion of said
- 5 flea market, report to the commissioner, the names and addresses
- 6 and taxpayer's identifying number of each vendor or rentor who
- 7 rents space from such operator or organizer for the purpose of
- 8 selling to the general public merchandise, goods, wares, arts,
- 9 crafts, antiques and other items or articles.
