AN ACT PROVIDING THAT STATE EMPLOYEES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
- 2 the contrary, all employees of the commonwealth shall be
- 3 transferred from the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the
- 4 General Laws to the federal social security law.
