AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN AN ALL PURPOSE RECREATION BUILDING ON SOLDIERS FIELD ROAD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct and maintain an all purpose recreation
- 3 building, including therein basketball courts, indoor tennis courts
- 4 and facilities for other indoor sports, on land adjacent to Faneuil
- 5 Pool, on Soldiers Field Road in the Brighton section of the city of
