By Mr. Mullins of Ludlow, petition of William D. Mullins (by vote of the town) relative to exempting employees of the sewer department of the town of Ludlow from the provisions of the civil service law. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT EXEMPTING THE SEWER DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF LUDLOW FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All of the employees of Ludlow sewer department
2 hired after the effective date of this act shall be exempt from the
3 provisions of chapter thirty-one of the general laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
