

Under the authority of section 4 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, I am submitting the attached legislation entitled "An Act Modifying the Membership of the Board of State Examiners of Electricians".

The purpose of the attached legislative proposal is to ensure that the composition of the Board of State Examiners and Electricians more adequately reflects the needs of the citizens of the Commonwealth. At the present time, the Personnel Administrator is a member of the Board. This proposal would remove the Personnel Administrator from the Board and replace him with a representative of the public.

AN ACT MODIFYING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF ELECTRICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32 of chapter 13 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by chapter 835 of the acts of 1974 is hereby amended by
3 striking out the first three sentences and inserting in place thereof
4 the following four sentences: —

5 The state examiners of electricians, hereinafter, called the board,
6 shall consist of the state fire marshal, the associate commissioner
7 for the division of occupational education in the department of
8 education, ex officiis, and five persons to be appointed for terms of
9 three years each by the governor. One of said appointees shall be a
10 representative of the public, subject to the provisions of section
11 nine B. One of said appointees shall be a local wiring inspector who
12 shall be an electrician licensed under chapter one hundred and
13 forty-one. One of said appointees shall be actively engaged as a
14 master electrical contractor and shall have had at least ten years'
15 experience as an employing master electrical contractor next
16 preceding his appointment holding "Certificate A" and "Cer-
17 tificate B" licenses issued under chapter one hundred and forty-
18 one.
