AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING TO DREDGE CERTAIN WATERWAYS IN THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of environmental quality engineering is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to dredge the channel and basin in the area
- 3 of the Braintree and Metropolitan Yacht Clubs located in the town
- 4 of Braintree so as to conform with the areas previously dredged.
- 5 The sum of two hundred thousand dollars is to be appropriated as
- 6 the state's share of an estimated five hundred thousand dollars
- 7 cost. This work is to be done under the provisions of section ten B,
- 8 of chapter ninety-one of the General Laws.
