AN ACT REGARDING NON-PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any General Laws to the contrary, any non-
- 2 professional employee of any school department whose employ-
- 3 ment is terminated at the end of each school year shall not be
- 4 subject to denial of unemployment benefits.
