

HOUSE No. 5511

By Mr. Businger of Brookline, petition of John A. Businger that the county commissioners of Middlesex County be directed to pay a certain sum of money to Melville D. Seibolt. Counties.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO MELVILLE D. SEIBOLT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, for
2 the purpose of discharging a moral obligation, the county
3 commissioners of Middlesex county are hereby authorized and
4 directed to appropriate from any available funds and, after such
5 appropriation, the county treasurer of said county is hereby
6 authorized and directed to pay to Melville D. Seibolt the sum of
7 twenty-three thousand and forty-three dollars and eighty-seven
8 cents, said sum being the difference between the sum he received
9 under the provisions of section thirty-four and thirty-five A of
10 chapter one hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws as the
11 result of an injury suffered on or about February seventh, nineteen
12 hundred and sixty-nine when, as an officer on duty at the house of
13 correction of Middlesex county at Billerica, he was in the act of
14 preventing a suicide attempt by an inmate, and the sum he would
15 have received had he received his full pay from the date of the
16 injury to April sixth, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
