AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH THE TOWN OF AMESBURY  
MAY BORROW MONEY IN ANTICIPATION OF FEDERAL GRANTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of section three  
2 of chapter seventy-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-  
3 five to the contrary, the treasurer of the town of Amesbury, with  
4 the approval of the board of selectmen of said town, is hereby  
5 authorized to renew federal aid anticipation notes of the town in  
6 the amount of one hundred and forty-eight thousand dollars  
7 payable in not more than one year from their dates, in order to pay  
8 the federal aid anticipation notes of the town dated June twenty-  
9 eighth, nineteen hundred and seventy-four in the amount of one  
10 hundred and thirteen thousand dollars and which was most  
11 recently renewed on December twenty-second, nineteen hundred  
12 and seventy-seven and payable on June twenty-second, nineteen  
13 hundred and seventy-eight and federal aid anticipation note of the  
14 town dated August first, nineteen hundred and seventy-four in the  
15 amount of thirty-five thousand dollars and which was most  
16 recently renewed on December twenty-second, nineteen hundred  
17 and seventy-seven and payable on June twenty-second, nineteen  
18 hundred and seventy-eight. Notes issued under this act for a period  
19 of less than one year may be renewed or paid from time to time by  
20 the issue of other notes, provided, that the period from the date of  
21 an original note issued under this act to the maturity of any note  
22 issued to renew or pay the same debt shall not exceed one year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
