AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF SCHOOL BUSES BY SENIOR CITIZENS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause (1) of section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "pupils", in line 14, as  
3 appearing in section 2 of chapter 878 of the acts of 1975, the  
4 words: — or persons over the age of sixty-five.
