RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF DIRECT ACCESS TO THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE IN THE WORCESTER AREA.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, five members to be  
2 appointed by the Speaker of the House, three members appointed  
3 by the President of the Senate, and four members, one of whom  
4 shall represent the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority, one of  
5 whom shall represent the Massachusetts Department of Public  
6 Works, one of whom shall represent the Executive Office of  
7 Transportation, and one of whom shall represent the Worcester  
8 Area Chamber of Commerce, to be appointed by the Governor, is  
9 hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study  
10 of the development of direct access to the Massachusetts Turnpike,  
11 with special emphasis, but not limited to, the Route 146 access area  
12 so-called. Said office shall report to the General Court the results  
13 of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,  
14 together with drafts of such legislation as may be necessary to carry  
15 such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the  
16 Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first  
17 Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.
