In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SERVICE FEES BY THE EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 17G of chapter 180 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 3 of chapter 1078 of the Acts of 1973,  
3 is hereby further amended by deleting the second sentence in the  
4 first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following  
5 sentence:—

6 The amount of such agency service fee shall be as provided in  
7 section 12 of chapter 150E of the General Laws.
