AN ACT MAKING ALL JUSTICES CONTRIBUTE TO THEIR RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32, Section 65A, Section 65B and Section 65D of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following
3 paragraph:

4 And all said justices of the District, and Superior Courts shall
5 contribute to their retirement system, the same percentage of their
6 earnings as other state and/or County employees, except that with
7 respect to those justices appointed to the bench prior to January 1,
8 1975, the provisions of this section shall apply only to that portion
9 of their salary which represents an increase in base salary as a result
10 of passage of the so-called Court Reform Act of 1978.
